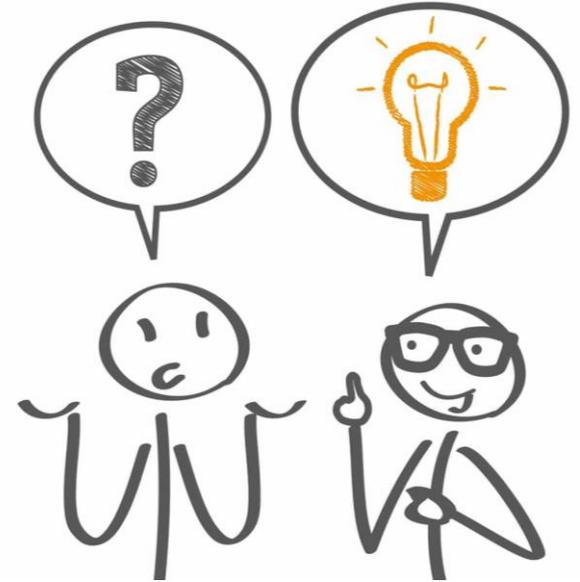

Early intervention in the context of drug checking

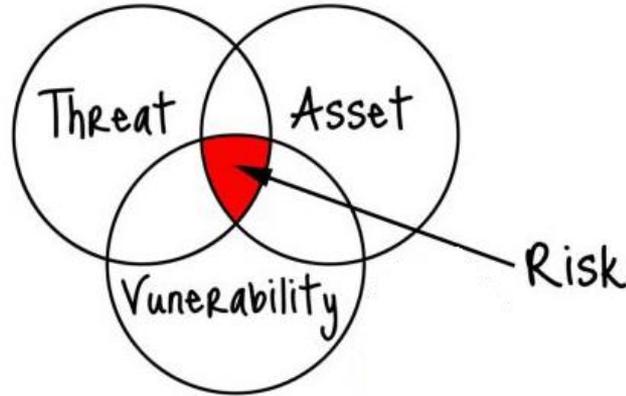
- Identifying the signs of emerging problems as early as possible.
- Analysis of the situation through an overall assessment of risk and protective factors
- Determination, development and implementation of appropriate measures
- Evaluation of the process and the effect of the measures



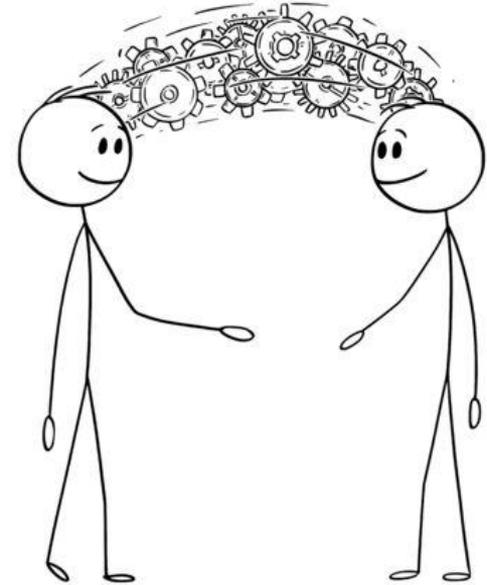

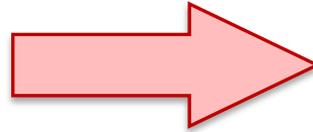

- Set und Setting



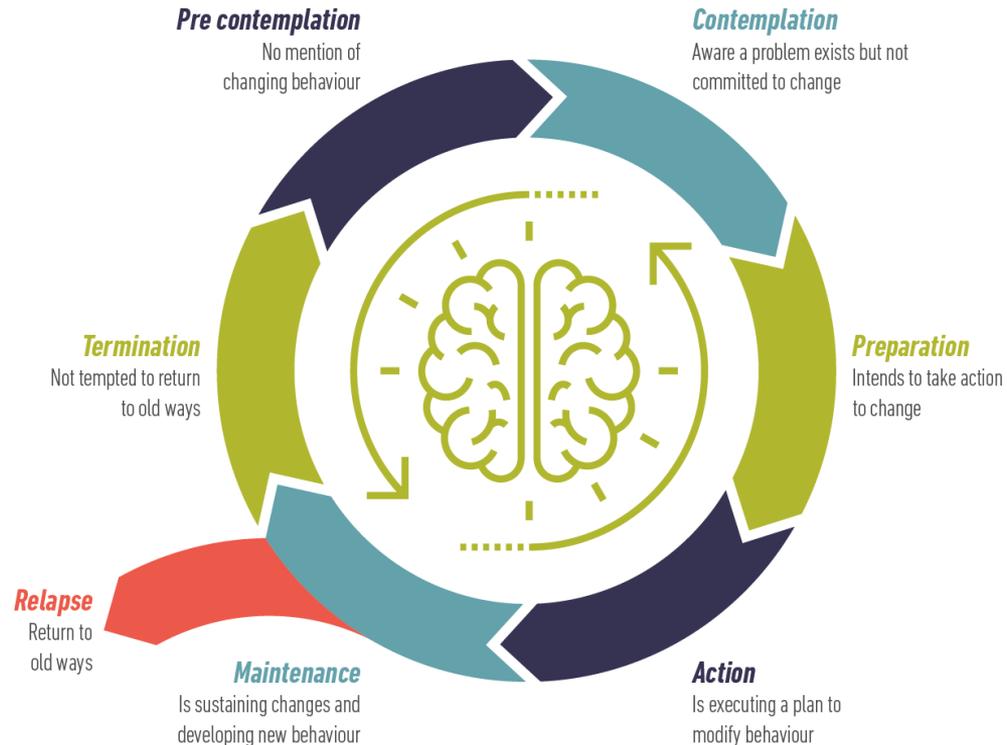
Levels of the questionnaire that can provide important clues for early detection

Motivation for behavioural change

Transtheoretical model of change (Prochaska, J. O., DiClemente, C. C)



Possible interventions depending on stage

- Pre-contemplation → infos / reflection of alternative perspectives/ building trust
- Contemplation → encourage self-reflection / Discuss the pros & cons of change
- Preparation → show various options / Support in the formulation of goals
- Action → strengthening of self-esteem / tips on how to deal with relapses
- Maintenance → Appreciation of the achievements made
