AKIM All-party Conflict Management in Munich

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AKIM – All-party Conflict Management in Munich

Overview

- Central office for conflicts in public spaces within Munich since 2014, located in the Social Affairs Department
- One head of AKIM and five conflict managers
- All-party conflict management with purely communicative means
- Promotion of socially acceptable coexistence of all user groups in public spaces

Application examples:

- (nightly) celebrations in public spaces at "hot spots" (e.g. Gardener's Square)
- Teenagers and young adults in parks, between housing estates,
- Stay of residential refugees and socially marginalized groups at their regular places

AKIM – All-party Conflict Management in Munich

Tasks and methods

- AKIM was the first body in Germany with an all-party approach to conflict resolution in the public sphere
- Contributing to the adequate handling of urban phenomena, i.e. the urban competence of citizens
- Support for all citizens at eye level strengthens well-being and subjective security
- Strengthening citizens' self-responsibility
- Creative mix of methods to deal with often unclear and diffuse complaints
 - Awareness raising, workshops, trainings
 - Conflict moderation and mediation
 - Coordination of conflict management measures
 - On-site presence

AKIM – All-party Conflict Management in Munich

Transformation and Cooperation

- Dealing with conflicts in the public sphere, expertise in committees, projects to support migrants in society
- Positive effects on urban coexistence
- Close cooperation with district committees, administration and other bodies
- AKIM feedback to administration and politics when decisions are required for the entire city
→ example: strategy process for nightly celebrations
- Role model for a growing number in other municipalities (e.g. Euskirchen, Nuremberg, Bamberg, Augsburg).
- Networking beyond Munich
 - Supraregional working group on „Communal conflict management in public space“ (focus on dialogue and non-violent communication)
 - Regional and supra-regional conferences

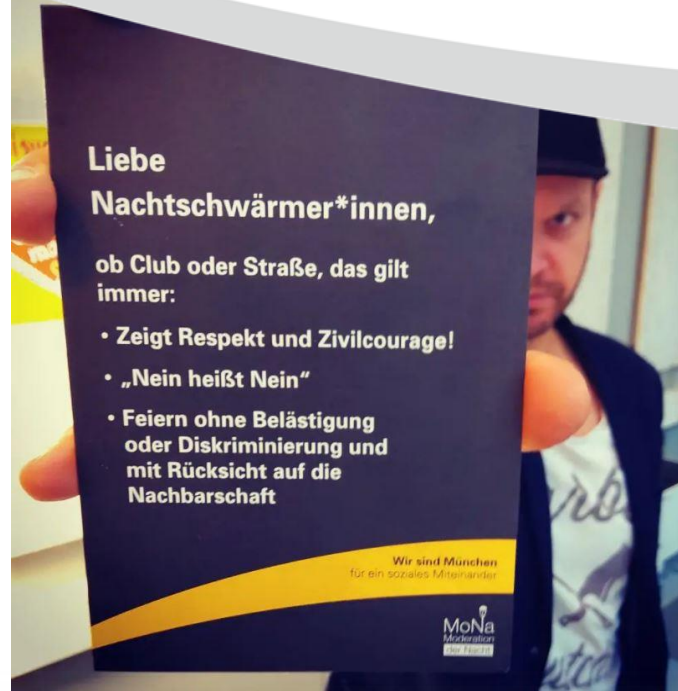

Emergence / background

- More and more identified conflicts in nightly context
- Strategy-process, hosted and moderated by AKIM
- One result: Munich needs a night mayor / night representative
- Social department conceptualized „Fachstelle MoNa – Moderation der Nacht“
- Start 1st Juni 2021 at social department of Munich



MoNa – Moderation of the night

Tasks

- More - Networking, interfacing, point of contact for all the players of Munich's nightlife
- Analysis of Munich's nightlife challenges
- Supporting and establishing projects
- Hosting and moderating the committee „Runder Tisch Nachtleben München“ (city wide round table regarding nightlife topics)
- Mediation
- Participation, communication, „translation“

- ...

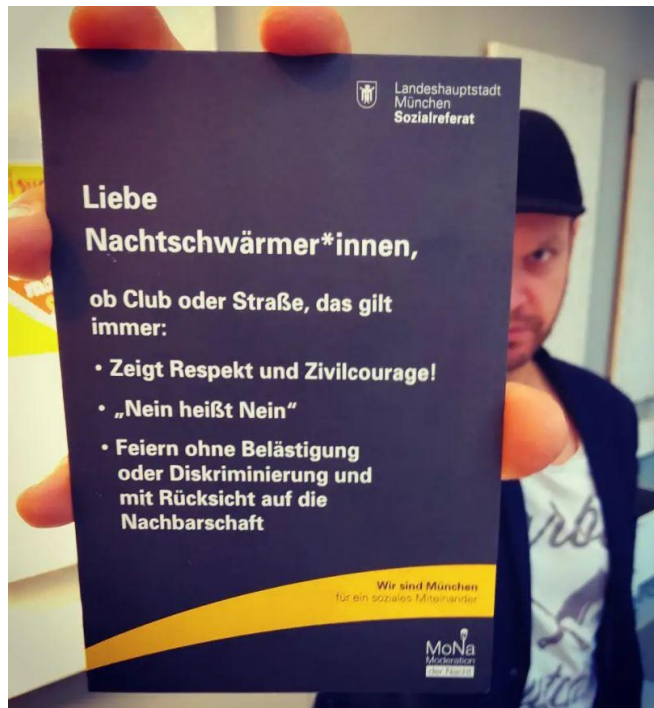

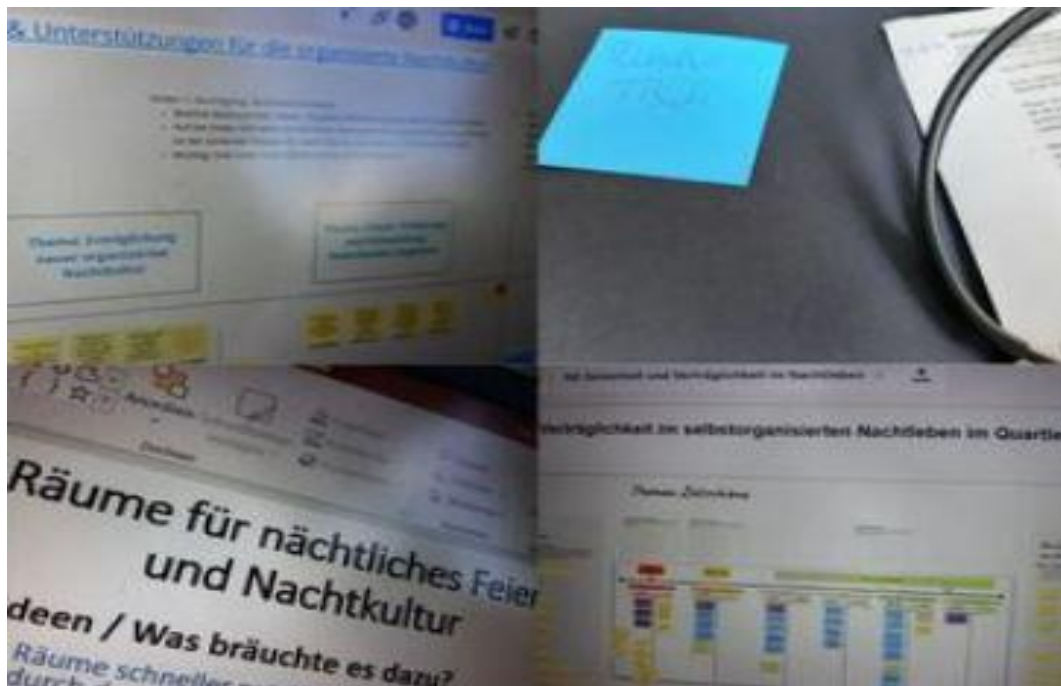

New common areas for young people

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Chillout Boxes

Existing recreational areas for young people

- Approximately 400 specific facilities for young people (skate parks, soccer fields, street and basketball facilities, playgrounds)
- 60 youth shelters (with roofs but without toilets), to make meeting, partying and chilling more attractive also in the evening hours and in the cold season
- However, Corona has shown: It's not enough. The need for additional spaces is high

Chillout Boxes

New recreational areas for young people

- In 2021 city decided to equip suitable green areas with 10 chillout boxes for young people (including mobile toilets) in the form of converted shipping containers
- Containers come ready to use
- Can be installed in an uncomplicated manner and are relatively inexpensive to implement compared to individual structures
- Site search in cooperation with relevant stakeholders
- Implementation by building department
- Financing by the social services department (financial budget: 250.000€)



Chillout Boxes

Evaluation Youth Boxes

- Well received overall by young people
- However, partial vandalism in individual cases
- Positive feedback from residents
- 6 more boxes will be installed by the building department by the end of March 2023
